# **COURSE SAFETY CODE**

## 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27-1)

- (a) Beyond any wall, hedge, fence or line of white stakes bordering the course.
- (b) On or beyond the line indicated by the stakes on:
  - i) The left of the 2nd hole.
  - ii) The left of the 8th hole
  - iii) The right of the 12th hole.

# 2. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RUI F 25-1)

All G.U.R. is play prohibited. Tyre marks made by green keeping equipment may be treated as G.U.R.

### 3. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES.

(Identified by stakes) If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: Match Play – Loss of Hole; Stroke Play – Two strokes.

# 4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 24-2)

- a) All artificially surfaced pathways. NOTE - When playing the 3rd hole relief from the path to the right of the green may also be taken in the drop zone.
- b) Sleepers and steps that are part of course construction. NOTE – Determine nearest point of relief without crossing over, through or under the construction.
- FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS
  All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them

In addition if such an obstruction is within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is (a) not nearer the hole. (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: Match Play – Loss of Hole; Stroke Play – Two Strokes.

# 7. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 24-1 APPLIES)

- a) Stones in bunkers.
- b) The stakes to the left of the 1st hole and the Right of the 13th hole. (Please ensure stakes are replaced).

### PUBLIC FOOTPATH ACROSS COURSE

Players are requested to exercise great care when pedestrians are using this path and to give them priority.

### **FLAG POSITIONS**



### 1. ON THE COURSE (GENERAL)

- i) Golf can be a hazardous sport. These guidelines are not exhaustive.
- Players are responsible for their own safety and that of others on the course.
- iii) Players should never play until the players in front are out of range.
- iv) Extreme care must be taken when playing blind holes.
- V) If a wayward shot is hit, players must shout 'fore' as a warning to other players even though there may be nobody directly visible.
- vi) Players to take note of safety signs at the Hole number marked with ( ) on score card.
- vii) Note that a public footpath runs behind the 5th green and crosses fairways of holes 6/11/12/13/14
- 2. First Aid: First Aid kits are in the Pro shop and De-fib in the changing room foyer.
- 3. Emergency Service Access: Via both the car park and the road to the driving range.
- 4. Emergency Postcode: LN119LJ

- 5. Emergency Telephone No: 01507 603681
- 6. Use of Buggies: Players must receive full operating instructions and tuition from the pro shop before taking a buggy onto the course. Golfers must be aware of cars when taking buggies into the car park
- 7. Greenkeepers / Contractors: Have priority at all times.
- 8. Application of fungicides etc: Warning signs to this effect are placed near the 1st tee.
- 9. Dangerous situations such as lightning, fog etc: Play is stopped by one prolonged note of the air horn. On hearing this, players should suspend play and leave the course. Under rule 6-8 (a) (ii), players may suspend play on their own authority where there is any danger from lightning even though the siren has not sounded.
- 10.Uneven surfaces: Players should be aware of uneven surfaces when walking. This includes burrowing animal holes and the like.
- **11.Trees:** Players should be aware of falling debris from trees.
